

# Floor cleaning & maintenance

The following information covers care and maintenance instructions to maintain your new floor so that it looks its best for years to come. Please use the cleaning kit that comes with your new floor.

## How to clean your floor

### Light Cleaning

1. Remove surface dust, dirt, and grit, by vacuum or sweeping.

### Deep Cleaning

1. Remove surface dust, dirt, and grit, by vacuum or sweeping.
2. Remove the bottle from the mop holder stem, unscrew the cap and fill the bottle: add 1 teaspoon of cleaning concentrate only and fill the rest with water.
3. Use the trigger to lightly spray the floor ahead of the mop.
4. Without lifting the mop head, walk backwards, working the mop head in an S-shaped motion (not forwards-and-backwards) to keep the dirt on the front edge of the mop head at all times.
5. Repeat steps 3 and 4 until the cleaning is completed.
6. Machine wash the removable mop cleaning cloth and line dry.

### Always

- ✓ **Always use** the cleaner provided by the flooring manufacturer.
- ✓ **Always use** a damp anti-static mop for the best results.
- ✓ **Always contact** the Floorboards team on 07 959 1861 **before using** any alternative cleaning product, even if it states it's suitable for your floor type.

### Never

- ✗ **Never use** highly acidic, corrosive or alkaline household cleaners, such as Jif, Mr Muscle, Handy Andy, Ajax etc.
- ✗ **Never use** a wet mop or leave water pooled on the floor surface.
- ✗ **Never use** treated or chemically-impregnated cloths.
- ✗ **Never use** a steam mop. The combination of excessive heat and water will be detrimental to any flooring surface.
